SOUPER BOWL SUNDAY ~ February 16 Team Messiah vs. Local Hunger and Food Insecurity



First, *thank you* to Team Messiah for your generous support! You have played a stellar game in helping us to reach our goal to alleviate hunger in our area by stepping up to keep our own food pantry well stocked this winter. Many families have benefitted from your kindness.

Now is the time of year when we get to have a little fun with the collection as we once again participate in Souper Bowl of Caring. Here is the challenge: While you are shopping for your Super Bowl snacks, could you please pick up a few extra things for the families in need right here in our own neighborhoods? Then vote for your favorite team in the Super Bowl!

For the next two Sundays, we will place *two* collection bins in the narthex: one for the Kansas City Chiefs and one for the Philadelphia Eagles. You may buy anything on the list of needs and place your donations in the box that represents the team you hope will win and we will see which one collects the most! All food items will be used to stock our own pantry. *Monetary donations* may be placed in the offering plate in an envelope marked "Souper Bowl Sunday" along with the name of the team you are rooting for.

Following is a list of items we collect for the food pantry:

Canned vegetables, *canned fruit*, baked beans, canned meats (*tuna*, chicken breast), *instant potatoes*, peanut butter, *jelly, maple syrup*, rice, mac and cheese, egg noodles, (please, NO pasta is needed, we have a lot!), spaghetti sauce, chicken noodle soup, tomato soup, cream of mushroom soup, canned ravioli (and similar items), cans of beef stew or chili, crackers, cereal, oatmeal, *PopTarts, pancake mix*, granola bars, cookies, dessert mixes (brownies, etc.), *snack pack pudding cups*, and microwave popcorn. *"Most needed" items are in bold print*.

More than 30 years ago, the Souper Bowl of Caring began with a simple prayer from a single youth group: "Lord, even as we enjoy the Super Bowl football game, help us be mindful of those without a bowl of soup to eat." It continues across the nation today, having created over \$170 million worth of support that stays completely local. *Will you be part of this movement that is sharing God's love with those in need as we fight to defeat hunger.*

The collection will continue from now through Super Bowl Sunday please give generously!

Camp Mount Luther is participating in The First Community Foundation Partnership of PA's "Raise the Region" on March 8-9, 2023. It is a 30-hour fundraising event starting at 6:00 p.m. and ending the next day at 11:59 p.m. Money donated by the Blaise Alexander Family Dealerships will help stretch

donations made to organizations that day. Additional monetary prizes and incentives will be awarded, too.
