2023 SYNOD ASSEMBLY REPORT

The 36th Annual Assembly of the Upper Susquehanna Synod was held at Susquehanna University, June 16 - 17, 2023. The theme of the Assembly was "Baptized into Christ: United, Supporting, Serving." It was based on Ephesians 4: 1 - 3.

The Rev. Dr. Gilson Waldkoenig, United Lutheran Seminary, was the Bible Study leader. His 2-part study entitled, "Unity of the Spirit, in the Bond of Peace" and "Making Every Effort," was based on Ephesians 4: 1-3. Dr. Waldkoenig stressed Paul's message, that we are saved by Grace, all has been done by Christ. Christ made access to God possible for all - Jew and Gentle, all those who live on the margins. When Paul left Ephesus, he continued to stress that everyone, including us today, should keep unity in the spirit and the bond of peace, because Christ has done it all.

The Assembly conducted the business of the Synod.

The Assembly elected Noah Roux as Vice President, for a term of 4 years. Elections were also held for Synod Council, Consultation Committee, and the Committee on Discipline.

The Rev. Chad Hebrink, Synod treasurer, reported that the Synod ended the fiscal year, January 31, 2023, with a surplus of \$53,798.35. The results at the end of first quarter, April 30, 2023, show revenue and expenses were in line with the amended budget, ending January 31, 2024. The Assembly approved the proposed budget, for the fiscal year ending January 31,2025.

The Assembly also approved the 2024 salary guidelines, for rostered leaders. This represents an increase of \$3057 over the 2023 guidelines.

Breakout workshops focused on discussion of how we can reach out and share our Christian faith, with neighbors and one another.

The Assembly offering was designated to be shared by the Lutheran Church in Liberia university project and the Upper Susquehanna Synod Fund for leaders.

The Synod office will move from its present location in Lewisburg, to rented space in Trinity Lutheran Church, Milton, starting July 10.
