This colorful book builds an intimate, approachable portrait of Jesus, who longs for our friendship as we long for his. Book is in the Children's section of the library.

Adult - **<u>A HIGHER JUSTICE</u>** - Award winning novelist James Scott Bell offers up another captivating legal thriller as Kit Shannon takes on two parallel cases, both pivotal in the burgeoning City of Angels of a century ago. The first involves a woman tragically bereaved of her young son; the second has the feisty and determined lawyer defending a down and outer accused of attempted murder. The sales are on! Pro shopping tip for the week: When looking for better prices on items depending on package size, *sometimes* the multi-packs containing a smaller quantity of an item are actually a better deal than packages containing a larger quantity. *Do the math!* ③

Items we are collecting are as follows:

✓ 70-sheet notebooks (wide-ruled or college-ruled, approx. 8" x 10 ½") – 4 per backpack

✓ <u>UNSHARPENED</u> #2 pencils - 5 per backpack)

✓ black or blue ball point pens (STICK pens – NO gel ink) – 5 per backpack
