Camp Mount Luther will be holding a 5- and 10- kilometer trail run race at the camp on **Saturday, September 2, 2023.** This is an entrylevel trail race on Mount Luther grounds with proceeds going to the camp. The start time for the race is 9:00 a.m. Runners decide on race day if they want to do a 5k or 10K (a double loop of the 5K) run.

Registration is \$35. Registration opens at 7:30 a.m. on race day. Shower facilities are available after the race. All miles for the course will be marked, and there is one water stop on the course. *There will also be a Kids Fun Run!* The age groups are 6 and under and 7-10.
