Reflections and Prayers on Exodus 23:12

¹²Six days you shall do your work, but on the seventh day you shall rest, so that your ox and your donkey may have relief, and your homeborn slave and the resident alien may be refreshed. Exodus 23:12



Refreshed! Boy, that's often hard any time, but being refreshed is especially hard in August. It's either the dead of summer or the dead of winter, depending on which side of the equator we find ourselves. Either place, we need to follow God's example of taking a day to rest each week and keep it as a holy time to draw near to him (Exodus 20:11). We need to hear God's desire for us to be refreshed by resting on a day dedicated to him, and to allow those around us to rest and be refreshed in his presence, grace, and rest, as well.

¹¹For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but rested the seventh day; therefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day and consecrated it. Exodus 20:11

My Prayer:

Forgive me, God, for allowing myself to become so busy at being busy that I don't intentionally take time to be refreshed in your rest. Teach me gently, Father, that I need this weekly rest in your presence and with my family to be all you want me to be and all I can be. Restore my soul, dear Father, and fill me with your restoring and refreshing joy from the Holy Spirit. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.



Camp Mount Luther Dandelion Run Coming Soon!

Camp Mount Luther will be holding a 5- and 10- kilometer trail run race at the camp on Saturday, September 2, 2023. This is an entrylevel trail race on Mount Luther grounds with proceeds going to the camp. The start time for the race is 9:00 a.m. Runners decide on race day if they want to do a 5k or 10K (a double loop of the 5K) run.

Registration is \$35. Registration opens at 7:30 a.m. on race day. Shower facilities are available after the race. All miles for the course will be marked, and there is one water stop on the course. There will also be a Kids Fun Run! The age groups are 6 and under and 7-10. Special awards will be presented to every participant in the fun run. Again, this year there will be a one-mile fun walk! Same registration fees and amenities apply. Walk will be on a dirt road. Timing will be electronically done. To register, visit https://runsignup.com/Race/PA/Mifflinburg/DandelionRun5k10kTrailRace. will be an awards ceremony following the races.

The Missional Outreach Committee is collecting supplies for School Kits for Lutheran World Relief to make it possible for children around the world to attend school. While our goal is to fill 250 backpacks, there are 371 sewn -- so

if we get extra supplies, we will fill as many as we can! \mathfrak{S}

We currently have enough supplies to complete 173 kits. Last year we were able to send 270.

Items we are collecting are as follows:

✓ 70-sheet notebooks (wide-ruled or college-ruled, approx. 8" x 10 ½") – 4 per backpack

✓ **<u>UNSHARPENED</u>** #2 pencils - 5 per backpack

 \checkmark black or blue ball point pens (STICK pens – NO gel ink) – 5 per backpack

 \checkmark safety scissors $\checkmark 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " eraser \checkmark box of <u>24</u> crayons

Most needed items are scissors, erasers, pencils, and pens.

Don't like to shop? <u>Monetary donations are also welcome!</u> Make checks payable to Messiah Lutheran Church with LWR School Kits in the memo line and place in the offering plate or in the smaller schoolhouse at the back of the church.

Items may be placed in the schoolhouse in the narthex from now through August 20.
