

LIFELONG FAITH FORMATION COMMITTEE (Christian Education and Youth Ministry combined) The Life Long Faith Committee (LLFC) plans and administers youth events and programs encouraging Christian growth, fellowship and service. This committee oversees all civic youth organizations sponsored by this congregation. This committee also oversees the administration and promotion of the Sunday School and educational activities of all organizations with in the Congregation. We encourage the use of teaching and worship materials published or apporoved by the ELCA, and seek to introduce the church's periodicals and books of family devotion into the homes of the congregation. One of the goals of this committee shall be to bring to the congregation's attention the call to the ministry of the Gospel and to other fulltime church vocations.

FINANCE COMMITTEE, of which the treasurer and assistant treasurer shall be members. The committee prepares a draft budget for the succeeding year, including this congregation's indicated share in support of the wider ministry being carried on in its behalf by the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America and the synod, and shall submit such draft budget to the congregation council for its action and later presentation to a Congregation Annual Meeting. The committee shall exercise oversight of all financial affairs of the congregation to make sure that they are being conducted efficiently, giving particular attention to the prompt payment of all obligations and to the regular forwarding of benevolence monies to the synodical treasurer. They shall, subject to the approval of the congregation council, be responsible for the congregation's investments and its total insurance programs. It shall make available all books of the congregation and its organizations for an annual audit.
