"SEEING OUR KING"

January 3, 2021 | Daily Devotions from the Lutheran Hour Ministry

After listening to the king, they went on their way. And behold, the star that they had seen when it rose went before them until it came to rest over the place where the Child was. When they saw the star, they rejoiced exceedingly with great joy. And going into the house, they saw the Child with Mary His mother, and they fell down and worshiped Him.

(Matthew 2:9-11a)

Picture the scene—Mary and Jesus in the house on an ordinary day. Mary was probably cooking or cleaning. Most likely, Jesus was playing on the floor, maybe with a toy Joseph had made for Him. It was a simple, homely scene. They didn't know the wise men were coming.

I wonder if the wise men were any better prepared for what they saw? Either way, they did exactly the right thing: they fell down and worshiped Him. They saw the real King, the real Son of God, playing in His toddler's clothes, and they were happy and celebrated.

We too see our real King, our real Savior, in the humble baby in the manger; in the Man in dusty robes who walked the roads of Galilee and Judea; in the Man hanging on the cross—our cross—to bring us life and forgiveness; and in the risen Jesus, who left the grave to be with us forever.

This is our King, and this is our God. Hallelujah!

Bible Study and Fellowship will begin on January 17, 2023. The Topic will start out with Angels. *All are Welcome!*




<u>The Library Corner - Highlighted Books</u>



Where is our library? It's above Shaheen Hall in the Education Wing. As you go in the alley door, instead of going downstairs, go one floor up and the door to our library is at the top of that one flight of stairs. (there is also an elevator that stops on that floor as well). Name of the room where the library sits is Jensen Lounge.

Using our library is easy. 1) select a book or video 2) take the card out of the sleeve on the last page of the book or on the back of the video 3) write your name on the card and place it in the small plastic box on the table in the library 4) pick up a card with the due date in the lid of the small plastic box and place it in the sleeve of the book/video 5) enjoy the book/video 6) return the book/video by the due date, placing it in the large plastic box on the table. **DO NOT PUT IT BACK ON THE SHELVES.** 7) choose another book/video and begin the process all over again.
