Díd you know.....

The Messiah Messenger was not our first publication. *Messiah's Missionary* ran from December 1, 1887-November 1, 1891. This was a monthly journal published by Rev. W. G. Thrall, Pastor of Messiah Lutheran Church. Pastor Shaheen started publishing *Messiah Messenger* in November 1940 as a weekly publication, except during July and August. July 5, 1970, we started publishing the Messenger every week including July and August. The Messiah Messenger always included the Sunday's order of worship and different articles the Pastors would like to share with us. In January 1979, the format of the messenger changed. It no longer included the Sunday's order of Worship; it included more information on the church including service schedules and calendar of events.

NEW MESSENGER - As you can see, the format of our Messenger is somewhat changed as we enter the New Year. We hope you will find the new format pleasing and informative. By eliminating the need for photographic reducing we can reduce costs by better than \$1,000 per year and the Messenger is more readable for you. The Order of Worship, previously printed in this paper, will now appear only in the Sunday Bulletin. But we plan for timely reminders for Ushers, Greeters, Acolytes, and others to always appear.

Since January 14, 1979, the Messiah Messenger has not changed too much other than the headings and designs. It seems that with every Pastor and Secretary we've had, things would change per their own styles and interests, but the one thing remains the same with each issue of the *Messiah Messenger* you receive, it provides information of the church and our needs to bring you and the church closer to one another. It is very interesting to look back in years past and see all the changes that have taken place in the church; all publications of both the *Messiah Missionary* and *Messiah Messenger* are available for anyone to look through, in the church Office.

I have included some photos of the past Messiah's Missionary and the Messiah Messenger and take notice of the differences. If you happen to see changes with your Messenger don't panic, it's just me adding my own style to the Messenger.
