Council Report - Constance "Connie" DeWald Estate



As you are aware, Constance "Connie" DeWald included Messiah Lutheran Church in her estate planning. Council members have spent untold hours over the last year getting us to this point. We have been receiving portions over the past

year which included a sale of her personal property to the congregation, followed by an estate auction of the remaining items. The sale of her townhouse was completed on August 2nd in the amount of \$159,900. The remaining jewelry will be offered to the congregation on Sunday, September 8th as a final tribute to her. It should be remembered that from the time we took ownership in August 2023, we have paid to maintain the townhouse in good order (lawn cutting, snow removal, utilities, etc.).

Council has prayerfully considered the best uses of Connie's gift. Some of the projects we think she would appreciate are the upgrades to the livestream equipment and the ongoing maintenance of our wonderful pipe organ. Remaining funds have been invested for future projects. Council would again like to thank Connie for her faith in Messiah to use her gifts to the Glory of God!
