Children - **<u>Bible Birds and Beasties</u>** - Did you hear about the donkey who talked? Or the man who lived inside a big fish? Children will love this collection of best-loved Bible Stories, with Noah, Jonah, Daniel, Elijah, the stories of Jesus--and a few surprises too, all quirkily illustrated by the amazing T. S. Spookytooth! Book on Children's shelf.

Adult – <u>The Eagle – Don't Despair, passages in the Gospel of John</u> – The Bible contains some of the most comforting, reassuring words in history. Many of these timeless passages can be found in a single book: the gospel of John. Ron Lavin begins his series on the gospels by exploring John's words of encouragement and how they still speak to us through the ages. This book can be used as a Bible Study or support group setting. It can also be used simply as a lifeline for people who need a ray of light in their own personal darkness. This book is in the Teaching Curriculum section.
