Readers young and old will be enchanted by Miss Fannie. They'll also discover

wonderful truths about trust and faith and the rewards of unselfish love. Beautiful book and story. This book is found in the Easter section of our Library.

Adult - <u>Martin Luther's Easter Book</u> - This powerful book of passages from Martin Luther's Easter sermons portrays the reformer's lasting thought on faith, human imperfection, salvation through grace, and the wonder of God. 
Kids Helping Kids! Another Kids in Mission is coming up on May 3.
