

2025 Upper Susquehanna Synod Assembly

The 2025 Upper Susquehanna Synod Assembly will meet June 13-14, 2025, at **Camp Mount Luther** (CML) under the theme, "Living into the Good News." This theme reminds us of our baptismal calling to bear witness to the

faith we profess as priests anointed by the Holy Spirit. Our witness comes out of our life together in the church in which we "hear the word of God and share in the Lord's supper" and from which we learn to "serve all people, following the example of Jesus" (*Affirmation of Baptism*, elw p. 237).

I therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, making every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and father of all, who is above all and through all and in all. Ephesians 4:1-6

Our church wide representative will be Rev. Norma Malfatti. Malfatti and Director of Evangelical Mission Sue Ellen Spotts will lead our Bible studies. Other highlights will include:

- Workshops on Friday morning with practical ministry take-aways.
- Installation of the CML Summer Staff and dedication of the new Maple Village Bathhouse at the camp.
- Festival Eucharist service on Saturday morning with some different ways to worship while honoring the traditions of our Lutheran Church.
- Consideration of a resolution to merge synods.
- Adoption of budget, salary guidelines, constitution amendments, and the election of a synod secretary.
- Blessing those who will attend this summer's Church Wide Assembly.

Carol Winter, voting member from Messiah, will be attending. In your prayers and private devotions pray for Carol and others gathering for the Synod Assembly, that the Spirit will strengthen, guide and encourage them in choosing leaders, proclaiming the gospel, growing the church, serving our neighbor, and doing God's work in an ever-changing world.

For All the Faithful Women *(Luke 1:45)* This is the theme for the 37th Annual Convention of the Women of the ELCA, Upper Susquehanna Synod that will be held on July 26, 2025, at Faith Lutheran Church, 2349 Old Turnpike Road., Lewisburg, Pa. For the in kind offering this year, we will be putting together *Period Packs*, which will be sent to CWS (Church

World Service) for distribution. Each WELCA group, attending the convention, is asked to bring the following items: **Regular Tampons, Super Absorbency Tampons, Packs of 12 Pads (unscented, long super thin)** Messiah has also been asked to provide *bath-sized soap* (*3 oz. or larger*). No Ivory or Jergens soap, since they have a shorter shelf-life and mold faster. Our plan is to pack 200 kits to send to CWS. Any extra items will go to a local Shelter. A box will be placed in the Narthex for donations, of above items. **All donations need to be made by July 20.**

Camp Mount Luther News: The summer camping season is soon to begin and staff training is well underway. The camping season will run from June 15 through August 1. You don't want to miss a chance this summer to get outside, make new friends, and feel God's love at camp. There are still openings for all **Camp Mount Luther** programs.
