


BECAUSE WE CARE...

For All the Faithful Women (Luke 1:45) This is the theme for the 37th Annual Convention of the Women of the ELCA, Upper Susquehanna Synod that will be held on July 26, 2025, at Faith Lutheran Church, 2349 Old Turnpike Road., Lewisburg, Pa. For the in kind offering this year, we will be putting together *Period Packs*, which will be sent to CWS (Church

World Service) for distribution. Each WELCA group, attending the convention, is asked to bring the following items: **Regular Tampons, Super Absorbency Tampons, Packs of 12 Pads (unscented, long super thin)** Messiah has also been asked to provide *bath-sized soap (3 oz. or larger)*. No Ivory or Jergens soap, since they have a shorter shelf-life and mold faster. Our plan is to pack 200 kits to send to CWS. Any extra items will go to a local Shelter. A box will be placed in the Narthex for donations, of above items. **All donations need to be made by July 20.**
